

TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER

ORDINANCE NO. 29

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16 OF THE TOWNSHIP WHICH ESTABLISHES A CURFEW FOR MINORS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE, AND PROVIDING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of South Beaver, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same:

I. Section 1 and Section 6 of Ordinance No. 16 are hereby amended in their entirety and the same shall read and be effective as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any parent to permit his or her minor child or any minor person under eighteen years of age, to be or remain in any public place, or privately owned establishment open to the public for the purpose of business, amusement or entertainment, within the Township of South Beaver between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., prevailing time, unless accompanied by a parent, or upon an errand or legitimate business directed by a parent with a written statement signed by a parent, or unless engaged in gainful, lawful employment, in which event such minor person shall carry written identification and evidence of employment.

SECTION 6. Any parent in violation of Section 1 hereof or any minor in violation of said Section 1, or any person in violation of Section 2 hereof, shall upon conviction of each offense in a summary proceedings be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-five and no/100 (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than Three Hundred and no/100 (\$300.00) Dollars, or in default of payment of fine and/or costs, be committed to the

county jail for a period not in excess of thirty days.

II. Section 7. This ordinance shall be effective five days after adoption, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable, and if any part hereof is held to be unconstitutional or illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions hereof.
