

**Minutes of South Beaver Township Regular Meeting**

**March 22, 2021**

The second monthly March meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the South Beaver Municipal Building located at 805 Blackhawk Road was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Jack Mintier. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Officials present: Jack Mintier, Thomas Miller, John Onuska, Dan Petrich, Ashley Carr

Others present: Owen Pella, David Syka, Alex Gill, David Sauba, Jim DiLonordo, Matt DeChicko, Mike Lansberry, Dave Woods, Randy Morrow

Jack Mintier made an announcement that on March 18 at 7pm he met with Tom and George Patterson at the municipal building regarding a litigation. The Supervisors also met prior to this meeting at 6:30pm at Station #2 for a meeting of employees.

Thomas Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of the March meeting. John Onuska seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Coaches from Blackhawk 13u and Matt DeChicko from BAYBA were present to work out their understanding of the Township field usage. Jim Dilonordo of Blackhawk 13u requested to use the pony field and to coordinate with BAYBA on scheduling. Jack Mintier commented that the field does belong to the Township and that the board would like to see the two organizations work together in figuring out scheduling without the board having to step in. Blackhawk 13u will reach out to Rick Shanor as suggested by Matt DeChicko and work out a 30 day schedule. Dan Petrich stated that if there were a conflict it would probably result in the police department getting called to the fields and he doesn't want to see that happen. Dave Woods said for the past two weeks there have been no conflicts in scheduling and that Blackhawk 13u would walk away before the police every got called to the fields. Mike Lansberry said there has been some concerns from BAYBA because some of their coaches like to prep the fields on their lunch break and don't want someone coming and messing them up. Mike said if they can see the fields are prepped they will make other arrangements. John Onuska stated that he was very thankful to BAYBA for the work that has been done to the fields over the years and also to the Lansberry family for donating their time and material to the fields. John asked that both organizations work together on scheduling and that he doesn't want to hear of any scheduling issues or the board will make the fields off limits to everyone.

The Supervisors informed Dan Petrich that at this time they will not be moving forward with hiring an additional full time officer and asked that he search for a part time officer to cover the 32 hour position. Thomas Miller made a motion to authorize hiring one part time officer as soon as possible. John Onuska seconded motion. Motion carried.

The Supervisors met with Code Enforcement officers Owen Pella and Randy Morrow to see what services they provide and also give them a little information about what the Township would be looking for if it decided to hire a code enforcement officer. No action was taken.

Jack Mintier adjourned the meeting at 8:00 P.M.
