ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 27 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER RELATIVE TO THE POLICE PENSION PROGRAM FOR FULL-TIME POLICEMEN AND PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF ADMINISTERING SAID PENSION FUND PROGRAM.

The Supervisors of the Township of South Beaver, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under authority of the Second Class Township Code and pursuant to Act of 1956, May 29, P.L. (1955) 1804, as amended, commonly referred to as Act 600, hereby enacts the following:

Section 1. SECTION 4 of Ordinance No. 27 is hereby amended in its entirety and same shall hereafter state and provide, relative to the administration of the Police Pension Program for Full-time Policemen, as follows:

SECTION 4. The expense of administering the pension fund program for full-time policemen, including but not limited to any service costs and actuarial fee cost, shall be charged to and paid from the funds held in the pension fund investment and/or cash fund account or accounts. Nothing herein is to be construed to exclude transfer of general funds of the Township, as may be necessary from time to time, to the pension fund account or accounts for the purpose of paying administration cost of this pension program.

Section 2. All other Sections, clauses and provisions of Ordinance No. 27 are hereby affirmed and ratified.
