

ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING FOR REGULATION OF TRAFFIC ON TOWNSHIP ROADS AND STREETS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of South Beaver Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted under authority of the Township Code and Motor Vehicle Code, the following:

1. The Board of Supervisors shall from time to time, designate by Resolution, speed, parking, or weight restrictions or other traffic signals deemed necessary for the regulation of traffic and use of roads and streets of the Township, which Resolution shall specify the streets or intersections and restrictions involved, and will require posting of proper signs in accordance with the terms of the Motor Vehicle Code.

11. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment.
