

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR REGULATION OF CONSTRUCTION, OPENINGS OR CUTS ON OR UNDER TOWNSHIP ROADS AND STREETS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of South Beaver Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted under authority of the Township Code, the following:

1. No railroad or street railway or crossing shall hereafter be constructed, nor any gas pipe, water pipe, electric conduits, or other piping, be laid upon or in, nor shall any telephone, telegraph, or electric light or power poles, or any coal tipples or any other obstructions be erected on, in or under any portion of a Township road or street except under such conditions, restrictions and regulations relating to the installation and maintenance thereof, as may be prescribed in permits granted by the Township for such purpose.

11. The application for a permit shall be on a form prescribed by the Township and submitted to the Township in triplicate, together with three (3) copies of a sketch showing such dimensions as the location of the intended facility, width of the traveled roadway, right-of-way lines and a dimension to the nearest intersecting street. The application shall be accompanied by a fee in accordance with the Schedule of Fees set forth by the Department of Transportation, for Highway Occupancy Permits and Restoration Charges, plus an additional inspection fee as prescribed by the Township and set forth on the application forms.

111. A permit shall be issued to the applicant after all the aforementioned requirements have been filed. Upon completion of the work, the applicant shall give written notice thereof to the Township and the Township shall inspect the work and, when necessary, enforce compliance with the conditions, restrictions and regulations prescribed by the permit. Where any settlement or defect in the work occurs, if the applicant shall fail to rectify any such settlement or other defect, within sixty (60) days after written notice from the Township to do so, the Township may do the work and shall impose upon the applicant the cost thereof, together with an additional twenty percentum (20%) of such cost.

1V. Any person, firm, Corporation or utility which shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject, upon conviction in a summary proceedings, to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300) Dollars and cost of prosecution, and , and in default of the payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment in the County jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

V. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after adoption and any Ordinance or part of Ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed insofar as it is inconsistent herewith. The provisions of the Ordinance shall be severable, and if any part hereof shall be held to be illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
