

TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER

ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR AND SETTING COMPENSATION OF THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of South Beaver Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted under the authority of the Second Class Township Code, as amended, including but not limited to Act No. 68 of 1985, the following:

1. Each Supervisor of South Beaver Township, elected and/or appointed according to law, shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public Meetings of the Board of Supervisors held for the purpose of conducting Township business and affairs, and for attending and participating in any Hearing required to be held pursuant and under the Local Agency Law, at the rate of Thirty-five (\$35.00) Dollars per Meeting or Hearing.
2. No Supervisor shall receive an aggregate of payments of compensation for performance of the duties of a Supervisor during any calendar year in excess of the annual compensation statutory limit set forth per the applicable population category/classification detailed in said Second Class Township Code, as amended.
3. Such compensation shall be paid unto each Supervisor not less frequently than in quarterly installments, but at the choice of each Supervisor, may be paid monthly.
4. This Ordinance and compensation provided herein shall be effective as of and after January 1, 1988.
5. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any part hereof shall be held to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
