

Minutes of South Beaver Township Regular Meeting

August 11, 2009

The regular August meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the Municipal Building on State Route 168 was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Matthew Balik. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Matt opened up the Ag Security Public Hearing. Donald Sherman, a member of the Ag Security Committee, was the only person present. No comments were received and the Public Hearing was closed. The regular supervisor meeting continued.

Bob Long made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Dan Rastatter seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Bob Long made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and pay the following bills: General Fund, Check #8375 - #8414, Total \$34,247.11; Payroll Fund, Check #6321 - #6344, Total \$20,191.09; State Fund, Check #1862, Total \$17,535.57. Dan Rastatter seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Police Chief Dan McLean gave the Police Report and it will be filed. Dan reported he has had complaints on ATV's riding on residents property and on the road. He had an incident on Georgetown Road and the ATV ran into the police car causing \$840.00 worth of damage. The driver is being cited.

Bob Long reported the Road Department was getting ready to tar and chip parts of Sherman and Court Roads on Thursday.

The supervisors granted an extension on the Carl Valentine Subdivision to November 9, 2009. This subdivision is located on State Route 168. A couple of items still need to be addressed and the private street needs to be properly stabilized. The Beaver County Conservation District will be checking on the stabilization.

A letter was received from Delores Nahar on the status of her land development. She wrote all correspondence from the DEP and Planning Commission has been forwarded to her engineer and developer.

The Board of Supervisors accepted the following bids for winter commodities through the Beaver County Regional Council of Governments: Matt Balik made the motion and Dan Rastatter seconded the motion. Motion carried.

200 Ton Rock Salt @ \$63.95 per ton from Central Salt LLC, Elgin, IL. Total Contract \$12,790.00. At least 60% of the contract must be taken.

500 Ton Type 3-A Anti-skid @ \$11.40 per ton from Three Rivers Aggregate, Slippery Rock.
Total Contract \$ 5,700.00.

800 Ton Cinders @ \$10.50 per ton from A.R. Oliastro, Inc., Ellwood City, PA. Total Contract
\$ 8,400.00.

A revised cost estimate and drawings for the South Beaver Recreation Park Grant were reviewed by the supervisors. These will be forwarded to the PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for their review and approval.

A letter was received from the Cohen Law Group of Pittsburgh on a joint cable franchise renewal with Comcast for the Beaver County Regional COG members. The Board of Supervisors do not wish to participate.

A notice was received from Brenda Wilson of PRINT saying she will be moving on with the township directory and map. She will be sending a copy for review in a couple of weeks.

A notice was received from Susan Boser, Water Quality Educator with Penn State, informing the township that two Septic System Education Workshops are being held on September 16th. This workshop will focus on the workings of a septic system, troubleshooting, and maintenance of systems.

Up-coming Seminar: Confined Space Training

Matt Balik made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Bob Long seconded the motion. Motion carried. Matt adjourned the meeting at 8:20 P.M.
