

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO AMEND SOUTH BEAVER TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 4, ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 1, 1962, BY ADDING THERETO BY REFERENCE THE PROVISIONS AND REGULATIONS OF ACT NO. 537 COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1967; AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF FEES IN COMPLIANCE THERETO.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of South Beaver, under and by virtue of the authority contained in the Second Class Township Code and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I

South Beaver Township Ordinance No. 4, adopted December 1, 1962, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Section IA

No person or party shall install an individual or community sewage disposal system, construct any building in South Beaver Township in which an individual or community disposal system is to be installed without first obtaining a permit from said Township indicating that the plans or specifications of such system are in

compliance with Act No. 537 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, effective Uuly 1, 1967, otherwise known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and with all rules and regulations adopted pursuant to that Act, all of which are incorporated herein by reference thereto. A fee in the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars shall be paid to the Township or its duly authorized agent at the time of making application for an individual or community sewage disposal system.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication and the adopted as required by law.
