

Minutes of South Beaver Township Regular Meeting

June 10, 2019

The regular June meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the South Beaver Municipal Building located at 805 Blackhawk Road was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Vice Chairman Jack Mintier. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Officials present: Jack Mintier, Thomas Miller, John Heyl, Dan McLean, Ashley Carr. Robert Wood was absent due to being called out after the storm for trees.

Tom Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular May meeting. Jack Mintier seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Tom Miller made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and pay the following bills: General Fund, Check No. #13818-#13860, Total \$28,490.30; Payroll Fund, Check #10121-#10151, Total \$30,193.47. Jack Mintier seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Heyl gave the engineers report. It will be filed.

Dan McLean read the police report. It will be filed. Dan reported that he expects Hannah Jones to return to work the first of July. The Police department received a notification from the Department of Defense Law Enforcement Support Office where they can obtain equipment free of charge and asked the supervisors for permission to sign up. The Supervisors were in favor.

A copy of the road report was distributed. It will be filed.

Ashley Carr gave the fire report. It will be filed.

No bids were received for the 1990 Pierce Lance Pumper that was advertised.

Jack Mintier made a motion to approve the Kerry Subdivision and grant a waiver to not show the entirety of two abutting parcels due to their size. Tom Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jack Mintier made a motion to approve the Fye Subdivision. Tom Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The following bids through the Beaver County Regional Council of Governments were accepted for winter commodities. Jack Mintier made a motion to accept the Salt Contract through The Detroit Salt Company for 200 Tons of Rock Salt @ \$84.25 per ton delivered. Tom Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried. Jack Mintier made a motion to accept the Anti-Skid Contract through McClymmonds Supply & Transit Co., Inc. for 1,000 Tons of Anti-Skid Type 3A @ \$14.88 per ton delivered. Tom Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Ashley Carr asked the Supervisors on behalf of the Planning Commission Board if it would be ok to advertise for a special meeting for Planning Commission on July 2nd to work through all the comments received from residents on the proposed zoning ordinance update. Jack Mintier made a motion to approve the advertisement for the special meeting. Tom Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.
