

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND GRANTING POWERS TO A RECREATION BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of the Township of South Beaver, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. A recreation board is hereby created for the purpose to operate and facilitate recreational programs, projects and services, and such recreation board may in addition, but being not limited to equip, operate and maintain parks, recreation areas and facilities, may employ and discharge play leaders, recreational directors, supervisors, superintendents, or any other officers or employees as it shall deem proper and adopt rules and regulations for the conduct of its business.

A. The recreation board shall establish standards, qualifications, and salaries, to be approved by the supervisors, for all classifications of recreational employees.

B. The recreation board may develop a cooperative plan of recreation service with other political subdivisions of this Commonwealth and with school districts.

C. The recreation board shall submit an annual report to the Supervisors, including an analysis of community recreation areas, facilities and leadership, with particular reference to the extent and adequacy of the program and its effectiveness in view of the public expenditure involved and the public needs to be met.

SECTION 11. The recreation board shall consist of five persons who shall serve without pay. Two of such members may be appointed by the township school board; otherwise the other or all such members shall be appointed by the Supervisors.

A. The term of each member shall be for a period of five years, unless such member shall voluntarily resign or be removed by the Supervisors for dereliction or neglect of duty; except that the members first appointed shall be appointed for such terms so that terms of not more than two members shall expire annually thereafter.

B. Vacancies in membership of the recreation board occurring otherwise than by expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term, and shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.

C. The members of the recreation board shall elect their own chairman, secretary and select all other necessary officers, to serve for a period of one year.
