

Minutes of South Beaver Township Regular Meeting

September 27, 2011

The regular meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the Municipal Building on State Route 168 was called to order by Chairman Matthew Balik at 7:00 P.M. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Officials present: Matthew Balik, Robert Long, Daniel Rastatter, Carol Miller, David Gropp

Others present: There were no visitors.

Home Depot in Chippewa who was awarded a cement contract until the end of February, 2012 has not provided a Performance Bond. They stated they cannot provide a bond. Our Township Solicitor David Gropp will send them a letter to cancel the contract. Since it is late in the year, the township will not readvertise for bids.

A letter was received from Boord, Benchek and Associates, Inc. informing us that a revised site plan is being submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for Well Pad Permitting on the Powell Site on Hodgson Road. It was previously identified as the Nancy Trautvetter Site.

The Board of Supervisors gave approval to reconstruct various roads in the township as proposed by Chesapeake Energy Corporation and its affiliate organizations providing Craig Baker and David Gropp review the plans and give approval to the township secretary. She will send an approval letter to the company who wishes to reconstruct the road. Dan Rastatter recommended the company provide detailed plans and calculations for the road projects.

A budget meeting was set for October 25, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. in the township building.

A letter was received from First National Insurance Agency on the renewal of our insurance for 2011/2012. There is a slight increase in the premium. The Statement of Values on our buildings was reviewed and signed and will be returned to First National.

A letter was received from the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors informing us our unemployment contribution rate will be 8.50 % in 2012. Our 2011 rate was 5.50%.

Matt Balik made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dan Rastatter seconded the motion. Motion carried. Matt adjourned the meeting at 8:15 P.M.
