AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS TO ANNUALLY ASSESS, OR CAUSE TO BE ASSESSED, THE COST AND EXPENSE FOR THE PURCHASE, PLACING AND MAINTENANCE OF FIRE HYDRANTS, WATER MAINS, FIRE HOSE AND OTHER RELATED DEVICES FOR THE PROTECTION OF PROPERTY FROM FIRE WITHIN SAID TOWNSHIP; PROVIDING METHODS OF ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Town-ship of South Beaver under and by virtue of the authority contained in the Second Class Township Code, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

I.

The Township Supervisors shall annually assess, or cause to be assessed, by appropriate Resolution, the cost and expense for the purchase, placing and maintenance of fire hydrants, water mains, fire hose and other related devices for the protection of property from fire within the Township by an equal assessment on all property, whether or not exempt from taxation by existing law, abutting upon any highways, streets, roads and alleys or portion thereof within seven hundred eighty (780) feet ofany fire hydrant in the district benefited hereby, in proportion to the number of feet the said property fronts on any highway, street, road or alley upon which a water main is laid, or within seven hundred eighty (780) feet of any fire hydrant on such highway, street, road or alley.

The Supervisors may provide for an equitable reduction from the frontage of lots at intersections or where from the peculiar or pointed shape of lots an assessment of the full frontage would be inequitable.

III.

No such assessment shall be made against any farmland, but vacant lots between built-up sections, either tilled or untilled, shall not be deemed to be farmlands.

IV.

All such assessments for fire protection shall be filed with the Township Tax Collector and collection made, deposited, reported and disbursed in accordance with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code.

V.

All resolutions, ordinances or parts of ordinances heretofore enacted, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed as far as such inconsistence shall exist.

VI.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon the publication thereof and adoption as required by law.
