

**Minutes of South Beaver Township Regular Meeting**

**June 22, 2020**

The second June meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the South Beaver Municipal Building located at 805 Blackhawk Road was called to order at 7:02 P.M. by Chairman Jack Mintier. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Officials present: Jack Mintier, Thomas Miller, John Onuska, Dan Petrich, Ashley Carr

Others present: Kevin Henderson

Thomas Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular June meeting. John Onuska seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Onuska made a motion to approve the reimbursement of insurance for the fire department for \$1,936 for the policy period of 06/15/2020-06/15/2021, excluding the old school property and they would like to see the fire department do two trainings per year. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Dan Petrich requested that the board approve the updated policy manual for the police department and asked for permission to get copies made. Jack Mintier thanked Dan for the time spent on updating the documents. John made a motion to approve the various police policies submitted by the Township Chief of Police on or about June 10, 2020 for review by this board, subject to later modification to cure syntax and spelling errors. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried. The supervisors were in favor of getting copies made of the policy.

Dan Petrich reported that the department is still trying to find a part time patrolman, they have someone interested but not sure they are able to work four days a week. Dan pointed out to the board that finding part time officers is becoming a real challenge and suggested looking into hiring another full time officer. A lot of money goes into training and uniforms with the part timers and there is such a high turnover rate.

John Onuska informed the board that residents have asked if the Township would rent out the tables and chairs from the fire hall. A discussion was held about who would be in charge of the rentals and Ashley Carr suggested the fire department could use the rental as one of their fundraisers. Thomas Miller questioned if there would be any liability if someone were to get hurt on one of the chairs. Dan Petrich made the recommendation to either sell or donate the chairs to the fire department. Ashley Carr will check with George Patterson and the fire department will be notified to see if they are even interested.

John Onuska made a motion to sell the 1979 SP Construction Trailer to Jack Mintier for \$225.00. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kevin Henderson informed the board that Chippewa may be interested in buying the boom mower that was a joint purchase between them and South Beaver years ago. South Beaver has had it the majority of the time and it is getting old, it would be a good use for the roads that Chippewa would need it on and our Road Department would need a new one. The supervisors asked Kevin to talk with Chippewa to see what they would like to purchase it for and also look into what a new one would cost.

Jack Mintier adjourned the meeting at 7:46 P.M.
