TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER

ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF MUTUAL AID AGREEMENTS FOR COOPERATIVE EFFORTS, AID AND ASSISTANCE FOR POLICE AND FIRE PROTECTION WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of South Beaver Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained under the authority of the Second Class Township Code and Act 180 of 1982, as follows:

- The Township of South Beaver, upon and after adoption of this Ordinance, is hereby authorized to enter into a mutual aid agreement for the providing of aid and assistance for police protection with the Borough of Ohioville, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and to the extent approval is required by the Township of South Beaver, the South Beaver Township Volunteer Fire Department is authorized to enter into and/or join in the mutual aid agreement with the Borough of Ohioville, aforesaid, for providing and receiving aid and assistance as to fire protection, and to also enter into a mutual aid agreement with the Negley Volunteer Fire Department for providing and receiving aid and assistance as to fire protection, all pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B", the terms of which Exhibits are here incorporated as though set forth herein verbatim.
- Upon and after adoption of this Ordinance, the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and the Secretary of the Township of South Beaver are hereby authorized to execute said Agreements, and approval is granted to the proper officers of the South Beaver Township Volunteer Fire Department to execute same also.
