

ORDINANCE NO. 17 - A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 17 OF THE TOWNSHIP WHICH LEVIES A PER CAPITA TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE DOLLARS UPON ADULT RESIDENTS OF SOUTH BEAVER TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of South Beaver, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained under authority of Act No. 511 of 1965, as amended, known as "The Local Tax Enabling Act", the following:


SECTION 1. From the effective date of this Ordinance, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 17 is amended in its entirety and shall be as follows:

Section 1. For general revenue purposes, a per capita tax of Five (\$5.00) dollars is hereby levied upon each person a resident of south beaver township for any part of any calendar year beginning the calendar year 1973 and each calendar year thereafter provided such person shall be eighteen (18) years of age or older and has an aggregate annual income of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars or more.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective thirty days after adoption.
