AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS TO ANNUALLY ASSESS OR CAUSE TO BE ASSESSED THE COST, CHARGES AND EXPENSES FOR THE PURCHASE, PLACING AND MAINTENANCE OF LIGHTING TO LIGHT AND ILLUMINATE THE HIGHWAYS, ROADS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN SAID TOWNSHIP; PROVIDING METHODS OF ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of South Beaver under and by virtue of the authority contained in the Second Class Township Code, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section I

The Township Supervisors shall annually assess, or cause to be assessed, by appropriate Resolution, the cost, charges and expenses for the purchase, placing and maintenance of lighting to light and illuminate the highways, roads and other public places within the Township by an equal assessment on all property within the prescribed area or limitation as set forth in theSecond Class Township Code in proportion to the number of feet as the same fronts on a street or highway or portion thereof to be lighted.

Section II

The Supervisors may provide for an equitable reduction from the frontage of lots at intersections or where from the

peculiar or pointed shape of lots an assessment of the full frontage would be inequitable.

Section III

No such assessment shall be made against any farmland, but vacant lots between built-up sections, either tilled or untilled, shall not be deemed to be farmlands.

Section IV

All such assessments for lighting shall be filed with the Township Tax Collector and collection made, deposited, reported and disbursed in accordance with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code.

Section V

All resolutions, ordinances or parts of ordinances heretofore enacted, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed as far as such inconsistency shall exist.

Section VI

This Ordinance shall become effective upon the publication thereof and adoption as required by law.
