

The regular September meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the South Beaver Fire Hall located at 740 State Route 168, was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Robert Wood. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Officials present: Robert Wood, Thomas Miller, Jack Mintier, John Heyl, George Patterson, Dan McLean, Susan Householder.

Robert Wood made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular August meeting. Tom Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was not available.

John Heyl gave the engineers report. It will be filed.

Dan Petrich read the police report. It will be filed. Dan stated that the Police Department would like to hold Simunition Training at the South Beaver Township Park on September 18, 2019 from 8:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. Supervisors approved them using the Park for training providing there was an attendant at the gate to protect the public from entering the park. Bob Wood stated he would ask John Betke to watch the entrance of the Park. Andy Leech offered to post it on the website as well.

A copy of the road report was distributed. It will be filed.

Susan Householder gave the fire report. It will be filed.

Robert Brieck inquired about the status of the sewage complaint he filed back in August. Bob Wood stated he was not able to give Mr. Brieck that information but would contact SEO Mike Groves tomorrow morning. Mr. & Mrs. Karczewski are neighbors of Mr. Brieck they stated that the sewage is running down their road and would like it addressed. Mr. Brieck also stated that the Burning Ordinance should be enforced.

There was discussion regarding a request for a traffic light to be installed on Constitution Blvd and State Route 168. Bob Wood stated that the township doesn't have the revenue to support the cost of a traffic light.

Bob Wood motioned, Tom Miller seconded to approve the amendment to the Zoning Ordinance. Motion carried.

Tom Miller signed the 2020 Minimum Municipal Obligation for the Police Pension Plan.


Jack Mintier motioned, Bob Wood seconded to approve financing the Caterpillar Utility Compactor in the amount of \$47,172.00. Motion carried.
