

Minutes of South Beaver Township Regular Meeting

June 14, 2021

The regular June meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the South Beaver Municipal Building located at 805 Blackhawk Road was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Jack Mintier. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

John Onuska made a motion to approve the minutes of the May meeting. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Thomas Miller made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and pay the following bills: General Fund, Check No. #14868-#14913, Total \$32,233.91, Payroll Fund, Check No. #10908-#10938, Total \$28,211.41, State Fund, Check No. #2105-2106, Total \$6,887.92, Fire Tax Fund, Check No. #133-134, Total \$46,976.24. John Onuska seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jack Mintier made an announcement that the board met on June 7th at 5:30pm for a personnel matter and prior to this meeting the board, George Patterson and Daniel Petrich met at 6pm in executive session for litigation.

Josh Callendar gave the engineers report. It will be filed.

Dan Petrich gave the police report. It will be filed. Thomas Miller made a motion to approve the police department purchase of 2 filing cabinets through Delaney & Associates for \$600.52. John Onuska seconded the motion. Motion carried. Dan updated the board that he is still searching for the part time officer to fill 32 hours per week, but has not found anyone due to a part time officer shortage.

Kevin Henderson gave the road report. Kevin reported that the 1 ton needs tires, he will get a price from Skander and email it to the board. Kevin had a rental contract from Stephenson Equipment to rent a bermer for Watts Mill road for one month. John Onuska made a motion to approve the bermer rental for \$9,500 and \$375 for delivery and pick up through Stephenson Equipment to be paid from the Watts Mill Turnback account. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried. Kevin informed the board that he would be meeting with Dennis Garrett of North Country trail tomorrow about building a turnaround for them by the bridge on Watts Mill Road and he will update the board on what is discussed.

Ashley Carr gave the fire report. It will be filed.

Mr. Siceloff and other neighbors of Lime Kiln Road were present to see what can be done about the ATV's traveling on the road. He said he is worried about someone getting hurt because of the speed they are traveling. Dan Petrich said that a complaint had come in last month and the police department has been out there more, but asked that they call when it is going on so someone can come out.

George Patterson updated the board on Blackhawk Hills and informed them that on May 11 he wrote to Dr. Grieco with six outstanding items. George did receive two items on that list that will be forwarded to the Township Engineer for review. Dr. Grieco was under the impression that three other items on the list had been complete, Josh Callendar will meet with John Heyl to see if that is correct and a new comment letter will be issued. John Nicely was present and said that #6 on the list, which is to close out the NPDES permit will wait until all other items are complete.

John Onuska made a motion to award Youngblood Paving, Inc. the contract for paving Watts Mill Road in the amount of \$668,310.50. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Onuska made a motion to approve resolution No. 8 of 2021, appointing a zoning enforcement officer authorized to issue zoning citations pursuant to the Second Class Township Code and the PA Municipalities Planning Code. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Onuska made a motion to appoint Joseph Budacak as the Township Solicitor starting August 1st. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Onuska made a motion for the police department to purchase backup guns and ammunition through Act 13 funds. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The PSATS News Bulletin for May was distributed to the board.

Jack Mintier adjourned the meeting at 8:05 P.M.
