

Minutes of South Beaver Township Regular Meeting

March 11, 2019

The regular March meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the South Beaver Municipal Building located at 805 Blackhawk Road was called to order at 6:57 P.M. by Chairman Robert Wood. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Thomas Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular February meeting. Robert Wood seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Robert Wood made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and pay the following bills: General Fund, Check No. #13670-#13727, Total \$46,383.27; Payroll Fund, Check #10026-#10049, Total \$23,964.45; State Fund, Check No. #2066-#2067, Total \$10,395.37. Robert Wood seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Valinsky gave the engineers report. It will be filed.

Dan McLean read the police report. It will be filed. Dan suggested that the supervisors consider raising the pavilion rental rates to be in line with other communities. The Supervisors said they will consider.

A copy of the road report was distributed. It will be filed.

Ashley Carr gave the fire report. It will be filed.

Pat and Sandra Mayer were present to ask the Supervisors for direction. They had a subdivision that was approved over two years ago and have spent over \$15,000 only to have papers from the DEP denying the sewage facilities planning module. When Emily Palmer was SEO the Mayer's hired a soil scientist to supply information to the DEP, which was denied. Then Michael Groves took over and the resubmission was denied because failed test pits weren't plotted on plans. Robert Wood asked John Valinsky of LSSE to get in contact with Kevin Brett and Emily Palmer to get this straightened out and contact the Mayer's.

Larry McCandless asked the Supervisors if we were going to transfer or get new plates for the new fire truck. The Supervisors want a new plate and asked Ashley Carr to contact 1st Out to make sure they have the necessary information.

Robert Wood made a motion to nominate Thomas Miller as the Beaver County Regional Council of Government Primary Delegate and Jack Mintier as the Alternate. Thomas Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Ashley Carr asked for approval from the Supervisors to use the credit card for \$400 to renew the Townships Dot.gov email and domain for the year. The Supervisors were all in favor.

A copy of the Second Class Township Code Supplement was distributed to the Supervisors.

A copy of PSATS News Bulletin for February was distributed to the Supervisors.

Robert Wood adjourned the meeting at 7:23 P.M.
