

ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO AMEND ORDINANCES NOS. 4 AND 11 REQUIRING AND REGULATING SANITARY DISPOSAL SYSTEMS AND DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE MATTER.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of South Beaver Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained under authority of the Second Class Township Code, the following:

SECTION I. South Beaver Township Ordinance No. 4, as amended by Ordinance No. 11, particularly Section IA, are hereby amended for said Section I A to be as follows:

Section IA:

No person or party shall install an individual or community sewage disposal system, construct any building in South Beaver Township in which an individual or community disposal system is to be installed without first obtaining a permit from said Township indicating that the plans or specifications of such system are in compliance with Act. 537 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, effective July 1, 1967, otherwise known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and with all rules and regulations adopted pursuant to that Act, all of which are incorporated herein by reference thereto. A fee in the sum as set by Resolution of the Supervisors from time to time shall be paid to the Township or its duly authorized agent at the time of making application for a permit, or at such other time as required, for compliance with this Ordinance.

Section II:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication and adoption as required by law.
