

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE OF SOUTH BEAVER TOWNSHIP,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IN RE
PUBLIC NUISANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of South
Beaver Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted
and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section I

From and after the adoption and passage of this Ordinance,
it shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, corporation or
other association, to create or cause to be created upon any public
or private property within the Township of South Beaver any activity
which shall constitute a nuisance.

Section II

For the purpose of this Ordinance,

a. The term nuisance shall include, but is not limited to,
the storage of abandoned or junked automobiles, or other motor driven
equipment or material part thereof, the dumping or accumulation of
garbage, refuse, trash, or other junk, including all types of dis-
carded personal property, or any other activity which may be considered
harmful to the promotion of the health, cleanliness, comfort, safety
and general well-being of the citizens of South Beaver Township.

b. The term junked automobile shall mean any automobile

outside of a fully enclosed building not in full and complete working order and without current registration plates, or any automobile stored for resale as junk metal, or any automobile outside of a fully enclosed building stored for selling parts therefrom.

Section III

No person, partnership, corporation or other association on whose property there is conducted or who is conducting an activity on the effective date of this Ordinance, which activity would constitute a nuisance within the meaning of this Ordinance, shall increase or permit the increase in size, use, or burden imposed by such activity upon the property so used or to adjoining property.

Section IV

For the purpose of enforcing the terms of this Ordinance, the South Beaver Township Police Officers or other authorized and designated officials or employees of South Beaver Township shall make periodic inspections of the premises where a present activity within the purview of this Ordinance is being conducted.

Section V

Any person, partnership, corporation or other association violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction before a Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars for each offense, plus costs, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, shall suffer imprison-

ment in the Beaver County Jail not exceeding thirty (30) days.

Section VI

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
