TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR AND SETTING COMPENSATION OF THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of South Beaver Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted under the authority of the Second Class Township Code, including but not limited to Section 515(a), as amended, the following:

- 1. Each Supervisor of South Beaver Township, elected and/or appointed according to law, shall receive compensation at the maximum annual rate of One Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 (\$1,500.00) Dollars, payable on a monthly rate basis of One Hundred Twenty-five and no/100 (\$125.00) Dollars, either on a monthly basis or quarterly basis as hereinafter provided.
- No Supervisor shall receive an aggregate of payments of compensation for performance of the duties of a Supervisor during any calendar year in excess of the annual compensation statutory limit set forth per the applicable population category/classification detailed in said Second Class Township Code, as amended.
- Such compensation shall be paid unto each Supervisor not less frequently than in quarterly installments, but at the choice of each Supervisor, may be paid monthly.
- This Ordinance and compensation provided herein shall be effective as of, on and after August 1, 1993.
- Any and all Ordinances inconsistent herewith upon the effective date hereof are hereby repealed. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any part hereof shall be held to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
