

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE OF SOUTH BEAVER TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING CONSTRUCTION, EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF ENTRANCES ONTO THE ROAD AND STREETS OF THE TOWNSHIP; REQUIRING PERMITS AND PROVIDING FOR FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of South Beaver, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of same:

SECTION 1. No private driveway, road, alley or street intended for private and/or public use shall be constructed or expanded so as to have entrances onto the roads and streets of South Beaver Township without first obtaining a permit for same from the Township and providing for the installation of drainage facilities at the intersection of same with the roads and streets of the Township in accordance with the specifications of the Township.

A. The person for whose benefit said driveway, road, alley or street is to be constructed or expanded shall file with the Road Supervisor or such other person designated by resolution of the Township as inspecting officer an application for a permit in form prescribed by the Township and with a fee in accordance with a schedule adopted by the Township, which application shall set forth the name of the applicant, the name of the contractor, the place of construction and the type of construction; and

B. Thereafter, the inspecting officer shall inspect the place of proposed construction or expansion to determine the

proper drainage facilities to be provided at such intersection and issue a permit to the applicant approving same, and directing the type of drainage facilities to be provided; advising the Supervisors of same; and

C. Upon completion of such construction, the inspecting officer shall determine whether same has been completed in accordance with specifications of the permit and shall make his report to the Supervisors; and

D. Any applicant aggrieved by the action of the inspecting officer in issuing a permit may within thirty (30) days after issuance of the permit request a review of the application by filing a written request of review stating the issues of disagreement with the Secretary of the Township ten (10) days before the next regular meeting of the Supervisors, at which time the Supervisors shall have and determine the applicant's issues of disagreement.

SECTION 2. It is and shall be the obligation of the person for whose benefit private driveways, roads, alleys or streets are constructed or expanded, now existing or hereafter constructed or expanded, so as to have entrance onto the Township streets and roads, to maintain and keep open drainage facilities at the intersection of same with the streets and roads of the Township.

SECTION 3. The type of drainage facilities to be provided shall be determined in the sole discretion of the Township Supervisors. The minimum requirement for such drain shall be as follows:

- A. An eight (8) inch corrugated metal pipe, or
- B. An eight (8) inch reinforced concrete pipe, or
- C. An apron of prescribed slope, width, depth and material.


SECTION 4. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall upon summary conviction thereof before any justice of the peace, or court of competent jurisdiction, be sentenced to pay a fine not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars for each offense, and costs, and in default of payment of fine and costs to be imprisoned for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.

SECTION 5. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any section, clause, sentence, part or provision shall be illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, the decision of the Court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections.


