

The regular October meeting of the South Beaver Township Board of Supervisors held in the South Beaver Municipal Building located at 805 Blackhawk Road was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Robert Wood. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Others present: Dayle Kelly, Bob Brieck, Lisa Sperling, Andy Leech and Larry McCandless.

Robert Wood stated that September's Minutes need to be corrected that Supervisor, Jack Mintier's name was omitted from being present. Also, August's minutes need to be corrected as well.

Robert Wood made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and pay the following bills: General Fund, Check No. #13954-#14038, Total \$97,194.38; Payroll Fund, Check #10216-#10283, Total \$68,753.47; State Fund, Check #2075-2077, Total \$2,922.42. Tom Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Dave Kovac gave the engineers report. It will be filed.

Dan McLean read the police report. It will be filed. Dan reported that there was a complaint regarding structures being erected on Cordak Drive. He stated, he reviewed the GIS and all the structures are accounted for in the Tax Rolls. Visitors: Robert Brieck state that Ordinance #52 and the Burning Ordinance need corrected. He also mentioned that there was unregistered vehicles on Cordak Drive. Lastly, Mr. Brieck inquired if South Beaver was a Permitting Agency for sewage permits and if so, he would like a copy of the Sewage Program.
